- Complete all tasks as directed.

- Online classes are available to all OUSD high school students.

OrangeLIVE! Classes

- All online classes are taught by OUSD credentialed, highly-qualified teachers.
- Teachers and students interact frequently via email, virtual class Elluminate sessions, voice boards, blogs, wikis and online discussions through the class Blackboard site.
- Teachers offer online and on site office hours.
- Teachers maintain a password-protected virtual classroom through Blackboard with postings of the course syllabus, regular assignments and class grades.

Time Span and Requirements:

All students **must** log in to their Blackboard course every school day. All online courses operate on the traditional semester schedule but have no standard "seat time" hours. Students enrolled in AP Art History, AP Biology and English 9 must meet face-to-face once a week at the designated campuses.

Technology Support: Internet access is required for enrollment. Access is available after school at all high school libraries. Technical support for use of the necessary technologies will be provided through online resources, teachers, and the Education Technology Office. Tutorials for software are also available.

Cost and Enrollment: OrangeLIVE! Classes are offered at no additional cost to students.
